

PARTY LIVELINE! SPECIFICS

Party Liveline is a five-hour Mainstream Top 40 radio show produced live Monday-Friday nights, with a Sunday night rebroadcast of the Friday countdown show. It is fed via streambox both live and on a two hour delay for Western stations.

- Eastern** 7P - Midnight
- Central** 6P - 11P
- Mountain** 7P-Midnight
- Pacific** 6P-Midnight

SETUP

The streambox requires a reliable internet connection and delivers 192 kb stereo audio and four synchronized relay closures to interact with station automation system. The closures trigger the legal ID, local spot breaks, the station voice stab ID (“Y101,” “B104,” etc.), and the show host read of the station ID. These last two integrate with the show production to give the program a local feel and frequent station branding.

- Relay #1** – Jock stab
- Relay #2** – Local spot break trigger
- Relay #3** – Mr. Voice stab
- Relay #4** – Station legal ID trigger

OPERATION

There are two stopsets each hour to enable local spots:

- 1) The :20 break is 3:05 and is optional...we feed a perfectly timed 3:05 length song if you don’t break away.
- 2) The :40 break is 4:05 and is a mandatory fill with silence during the break. Note in the fifth hour of the show the 4:05 mandatory break is at :55 to end the show.

A music “conflict list” is emailed weekly listing the current songs played in the first hour of each night so you can prevent playing the same song in your last hour prior to the show. Any questions, or for assistance, email info@jamchannel.com or you may text or call 617.261.6000.
